

## 8. Materials Guide

As a general rule, the SuperStar Excel Machine will cut anything that scissors will cut. The number of pieces of material that it will cut depends on the thickness of the material to be cut and the size and complexity of the die design.

- When cutting felt, poly foam or delicate materials, place a scrap of paper over the material to be cut.
- It may be necessary to use fewer sheets of material with intricate shapes.
- Use only one sheet of material when cutting with a Crease-Rule die.

Cork, Self-Adhesive 1/8"	Sandpaper, Fine 00 (paper side up); limit usage, can wear rule on die
Decorator Foil	Shelving Paper, Adhesive
Embossing Rubber	Shiny Paper, Self-Adhesive
Fabric (Cotton, Linen, etc., as many pieces as will fit with a piece of paper)	Shrink Film
Fabric, Iron-On	Sponge, Pop-Up
Felt (as many pieces as will fit with a piece of paper)	Tag Board
Felt, Self-Adhesive	Tin .008
Fun Foam	Tissue, Laminated
Funky Film	Vellum Paper
Funky Fur	Vinyl, Static Cling
Gift Wrap	Wallpaper
