The Friends take part in both Amazon Smile and Kroger Community Rewards (NPO#92908). They also continually run a book sale in the library's multipurpose room.

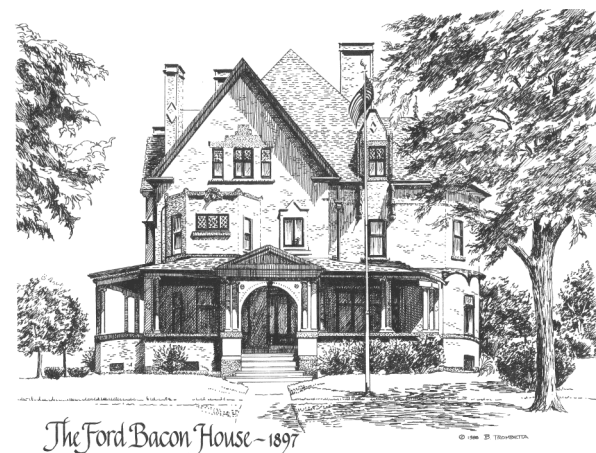
