



YARN WALL HANGING

Supplies

- 1 wooden dowel
- 1 hanging string
- Various yarn & beads

Optional:

- Scissors
- A wall hook to hang it

NOTE: You don't need to use all of the enclosed yarn or every color. There will be extra left over and that's okay. Just pick your favorite!

Directions:

Step 1: Pick out which color yarn you want to use for your Wall Hanger.

Step 2: Loop your selected yarn over the wooden dowel using a Lark's Head Knot. Think about what kind of pattern you'd like to make as you go. To make your loops, you can wrap each strand individually or in larger groups to create a fuller look like the example (Be sure to leave around 1" of space on each side to tie your hanging string.)

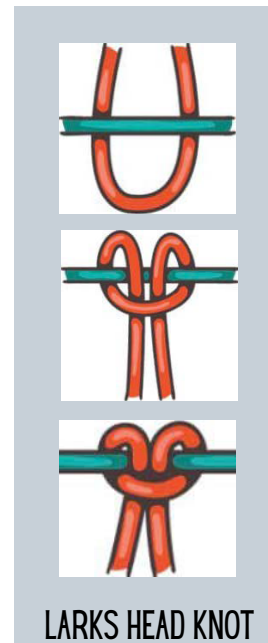
Step 3: Use scissors to shape your wall hanger.

Do you want it to hang in a straight line or in a "V" shape?

Step 4: Next, decide if you want to add any beads or braids to your decor. Tie a knot at the bottom of your braid or under the bead(s) to keep them in place.

Step 5: Pick a strand of leftover yarn to use as your hanging string. Wrap the yarn around the end of the wooden dowel until most of the remaining wood is covered then tie a knot. Decide how long of a hanging string you want then repeat this step on the other side. Use scissors to cut any left over yarn.

Step 6: Retighten any loops that have come loose and hang on wall!
